## Title VI Plan Statement

Adopted October 18, 2012

Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 prohibits discrimination on the basis of race, color, or national origin in programs and activities receiving Federal financial assistance. Specifically, Title VI provides that "no person in the United States shall, on the ground of race, color, or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance" (42 U.S.C. Section 2000d).

Champaign Transit System (CTS) is committed to ensuring that no person is excluded from participation in, or denied the benefits of its transit services on the basis of race, color, or national origin, as protected by Title VI in Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Circular 4702.1.B.

Any person who believes he or she has been denied benefits or excluded from participation in CTS services on the basis of race, color, or national origin (including Limited English Proficiency) may file a complaint pursuant to Title VI and/or related statutes.
